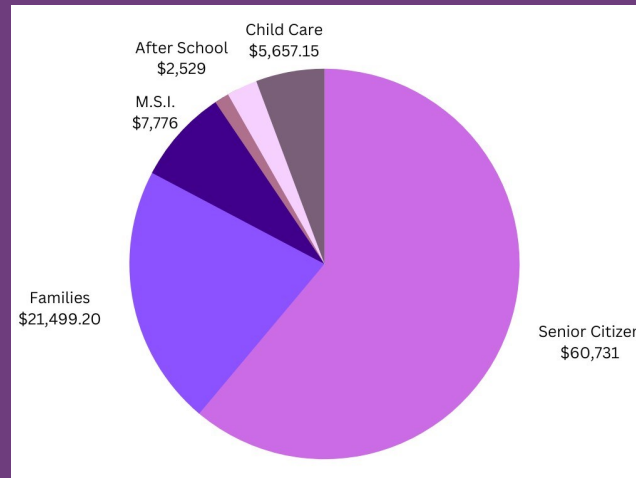
Elementary School students in the Y after school program benefit from financial assistance, providing a safe experience during out of school time.
